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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Deen Dayal Upadhyay Government Post Graduate College, Saidabad, Prayagraj-221508, hereafter referred as the First Party

AND

Innovation and Incubation Hub MNNIT Foundation (IIHMF), Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad, Prayagraj- 211004, hereafter referred as a Second Party.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 24th February 2026, Tuesday at Innovation and Incubation Hub MNNIT Foundation, Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad, Prayagraj

1. PREAMBLE

Deen Dayal Upadhyay Government Post Graduate College, Saidabad, Prayagraj a Government Higher Educational Institution represented by its Principal/Head of Institution (First Party), and Innovation and Incubation Hub MNNIT Foundation (IIHMF), is a section 8 Company promoted by Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad, Prayagraj-211004, represented by any of the its Director/ and CEO (Second Party), collectively referred to as the 'Parties'.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this MoU is to establish academic, technical, and entrepreneurial collaboration to promote innovation, startup culture, skill development, and employability of students.

3. AREAS OF COOPERATION (Scope of MoU)

3.1 Industrial Training & Visits

Industry-Institution interaction under this MoU shall provide valuable exposure to the latest developments, technological advancements, and industry requirements.

The Second Party shall permit faculty members and students of the First Party to visit its group companies, incubation facilities, partner industries, or associated organizations, as applicable.

The Second Party shall also facilitate participation of students in Industrial Training Programs, internship initiatives, and practical exposure modules designed to enhance their technical competence, professional confidence, and readiness for smooth transition into the workforce.

Further, the Second Party may register on the AICTE Internship Portal or similar platforms, wherever applicable, for the benefit of students of the First Party to access structured internship opportunities.

3.2 Guest Lectures

The Second Party shall extend necessary academic and technical support by arranging expert lectures, guest sessions, workshops, and knowledge-sharing programs for the students of the First Party.

Such sessions may focus on emerging technology trends, industry requirements, innovation practices, skill enhancement, and in-house operational insights relevant to employability and professional development.

3.3 Placement of Trained Students

The Second Party shall actively engage in supporting the training delivery process and facilitating placement opportunities for students of the First Party.

Placement facilitation shall align with prevailing technology trends, industry requirements, and in-house needs of the Second Party or its associated entities. However, final selection of candidates shall remain subject to applicable eligibility criteria and recruitment policies.

3.4 Financial Commitment

There shall be no financial commitment or mandatory financial obligation on the part of either Party under this Memorandum of Understanding for undertaking any activity, program, training, visit, lecture, internship, placement initiative, or collaborative engagement mentioned herein.

Specifically, Deen Dayal Upadhyay Government Post Graduate College, Saidabad (First Party) shall not be required to incur any financial expenditure by virtue of this MoU unless mutually agreed upon in writing.

Similarly, Innovation and Incubation Hub MNNIT Foundation (Second Party) shall not be under any financial liability or funding obligation unless expressly agreed through a separate written arrangement.

In the event that any collaborative activity involves financial consideration, honorarium, resource allocation, or cost-sharing, the same shall be governed by a separate written agreement duly approved and executed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

Nothing contained in this MoU shall be construed as creating any financial partnership, joint venture, revenue-sharing arrangement, or binding funding commitment between the Parties.

3.5 Approvals and Compliance

Both Parties shall obtain all necessary internal approvals, consents, permissions, statutory clearances, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for the effective implementation of activities under this MoU

4. Cooperation Framework

The Parties shall collaborate in mutual interest and execute activities through written communication and mutually agreed action plans.





5. Validity & Termination
